
Go to the upper right hand corner and click on create account.


Read the i-Safe personal information disclaimer, then click "OK".

Once a parent or guardian has validated that their child's personal safety is not at risk, it becomes a parental decision as to whether or not the child proceeds with providing the information being requested online. 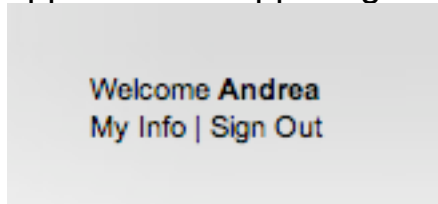

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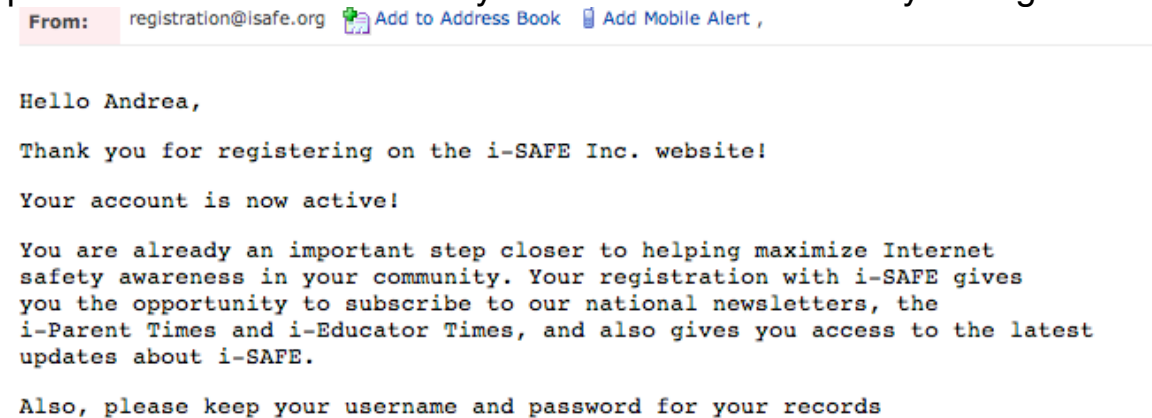
Step 10

Click continue. You should now be logged in and your name should appear in the upper right hand corner of the home page.



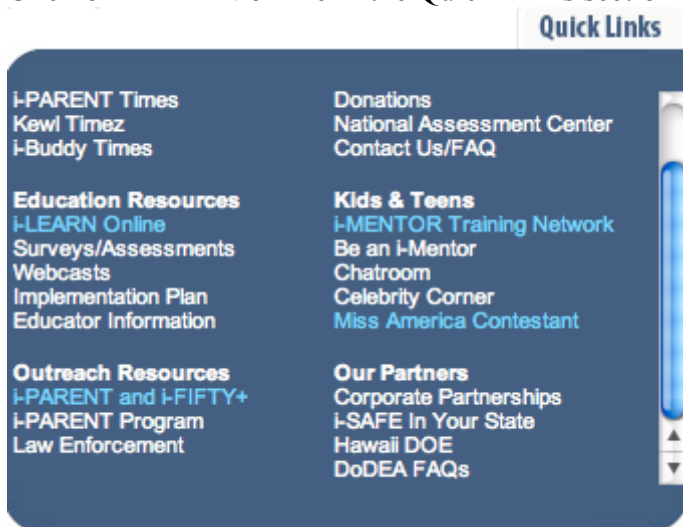

Step One: Print or download "Procedures" and "Activities." You will find these two PDF documents above. You will be asked to reference these throughout the viewing of this online module.

Step Two: Click "view online" OR "download" to watch each chapter. To "view online" you must have cable or DSL Internet and Macromedia Flash. If you do not have the free Flash program it will be offered to you when you click "view online."

Step Three: View each chapter in sequential order until all chapters are viewed and this module has been completed in its entirety. You must allow the window with the video to close on its own or you will not receive credit for viewing the entire video. You may view the chapters within your own timeframe but all chapters must be completed before you will receive i-SAFE curriculum material to teach this lesson.

Step Four: Submit an Implementation Plan to access the i-SAFE curriculum. Once you view all the chapters in this module a link will appear above these steps titled "Submit an Implementation Plan." Click on the link and follow the prompts. Once a module is completed, this link is always available to you.

Step Five: Once your Implementation Plan is submitted, the Materials Download link will appear. Click here to access your curriculum resources. The link will remain until the day your classroom instruction is scheduled to begin. If you do not download material before then you will need to resubmit an Implementation Plan.
